5. The Resolutions Committee report was made by Ollie Harris, and the report included the following names deceased since our last meeting:

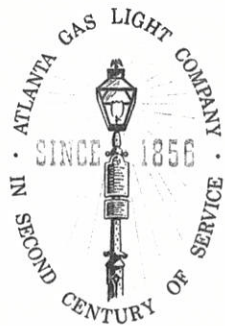
